**2007 UMPIRE'S AGREEMENT**

The following agreements are made between \_\_\_\_\_(name) and the Lane County Umpires Association (LCUA).

Appointment to the roster of umpires by the LCUA does not carry any obligation on the part of the LCUA to make any specific number or type of assignments. Assignments made may include any or all types of games contracted by the LCUA and its client institutions. Any assignments made may be canceled or rearranged as is deemed necessary by the LCUA Commissioner.

The above named umpire is an independent contractor and not an employee of the LCUA, nor of its agents, nor of any of the clients served by the LCUA.

All travel arrangements to the site of each game to which the above named umpire may be assigned are the sole responsibility of the individual umpire.

The umpire is responsible to purchase the National Federation rules packet and OSAA insurance policies. No games will be assigned unless said packets and policies are purchased. The umpire understands and agrees that neither the LCUA nor any of the institutions it serves provides Worker's Compensation Insurance benefits for umpires, as each umpire is an independent contractor and not an employee of the LCUA or the clients serviced by the LCUA.

The umpire agrees to hold harmless and indemnify the LCUA, its agents, and the institutions it serves, from any and all liability imputed to them for injuries or damages caused to any person or property solely due to any negligent or intentional act or omission of the umpire arising out of the umpire's assignment(s) to provide services at any athletic contest, game, or event.

The umpire agrees to hold harmless the LCUA, its agents and the institutions it serves, from any injury or damage suffered by the umpire in his/her capacity as an official, unless the injury or damage is caused solely by the misconduct or negligence of the LCUA, its agents, or the clients it serves.

The umpire warrants that he/she is physically fit commensurate with the rigors of baseball officiating. The umpire further agrees that he/she will stay in physical condition fit to perform the duties required of an umpire. The umpire will promptly notify the LCUA or its agents any time that his/her condition, for any reason, would interfere with the performance of his/her officiating duties.

The above named official agrees to pay all annual dues set by the LCUA, certification fees as set by client groups, and liability insurance as required by client groups.

During the term of these agreements, either the LCUA or the umpire may terminate them, without cause, upon ten (10) days written notice to the other party.

The terms of this agreement begin on the date signed by both parties and expire on December 31, 2007.

The above named umpire and the LCUA agree that each has read and understands the foregoing conditions and will abide by them.
